Online Entry Process & Deadline:

Entries are completed at <http://wi.milesplit.com/>. The deadline for entries will be at noon on April 13. Coaches should review all entries prior to the deadline.

Changes or additions will not be made the day of the event, only scratches after the deadline. The limit per team, per event is three (3). An individual may enter in a maximum of four (4) events but no more than three (3) running events or three (3) field events. Boys and girls relay teams may enter one (1) relay team for each relay (3200, 1600, 800, and 400).

Scoring:

Eight places will be scored in individual events and in relays (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1).

Awards:

Medals will be awarded to athletes placing 1st and 2nd in each event. Team trophies will be awarded to the first place Boys and the first place Girls Teams. There will be no awards ceremony at the conclusion of the event. Each team will receive an envelope with awarded accolades. Coaches please report to the center field box prior to your team leaving at the end of the invite.

Other Notes:

- Three (3) throws will be allowed in both the shot put and discus events and three (3) jumps allowed in the long jump and triple jump events.
- No trials/finals in any running or field event.
- Sprints will be seeded slow to fast in heats.
- ¼ inch pyramid spikes are permitted for all events.
- Only coaches, athletes competing in the next event, and authorized event personnel are permitted inside of the field gate.
- Concessions available.
- Weather will be monitored and adjustments will be made accordingly
