Rules:

- ¼" pyramid spikes (NO PINS) are allowed!
- No pole-vault will be conducted.
- Chalk only. No Tape. Any tape found will be removed
- Events will be combined boys and girls when possible.
- Please remind athletes to listen for their events. We will not hold an event for a late arriving participant.
- Athletes will only be allowed on the infield if they are competing in the high jump or if they are checked in for a running event with the clerk and he/she has placed the athlete in the in-field.
- Athletes need to check in for field events prior to the start of the event or they will not be able to compete.
- Athletes will have 15 minutes from called name to complete their jump/throw in the finals

Trainer: Athletic Trainer will be set up near the finish line.

Awards: medals for $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ place in all events

Trophies for 1st place boys and 1st place girls

Admission: Free

Concessions: A concession stand will be available on site.

Buses: You may drop off near the athletic shed off of Royall Ave. and then park in the Methodist church parking lot just across the road from the track.

Entry Limitations are as Follows:

- 1. You may enter up to three athletes in each event with a maximum of 28 total entries.
- 2. One relay team per relay event
- 3. Athletes are limited to a maximum of four events, with no more than three running or three field.
