Coaches Meeting	Will be at 3:15 pm in Room 156 of McFarland High School. Enter Door U on the north end of the stadium by the pool.		
Entries	We will be using a <i>thirty (30) individual entry limit</i> . Each GIRLS team is allowed one entry per relay event and up to three athletes in each open event. Each BOYS team is also allowed one entry per relay event and up to three athletes in each open event. Essentially, you'll have two bonus entries you can add in any event you'd like, or have less in an event and more in others. This is an early season meet, so we want kids competing.		
	Entries will be through MileSplit at wi.milesplit.com with an entry deadline set for 12:00 p.m. on Thursday April 10th. Scratches of missing athletes will be allowed the day of the meet. Meet information and the link for entries can be found under "Meet Information" on AccuRace Timing Services' website at www.accuracetiming.com .		
Field and Running Events	We will follow the WIAA Tournament Series format for field events – boys pole vault, boys triple jump, boys discus, girls high jump, girls long jump and girls shot put will be contested first, with the other gender beginning approximately fifteen minutes following the conclusion of finals.

Scoring	Eight places will be scored in all events – 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1.		
Prelims/Finals	Preliminaries and finals will be run in the 100m dash and 100m/110m high hurdles. In the shot put, discus, long jump and triple jump each athlete will get three attempts in trials. The top nine athletes will advance to finals.		
Opening Heights	Opening heights for Pole Vault and High jump will be determined at the coaches meeting		
Spikes	%" Pyramid spikes ONLY . Pin/needle type, or spikes longer than %" are NOT allowed on our facility. Spikes are NOT allowed to be on the synthetic turf surface areas of the facility.		
Athletic Trainer	UW Sports medicine will provide athletic training services.		
Awards	Medals will be awarded for the top three finishers in each event. Medals can be picked up after the meet up in the press box.		
Restricted Areas	We ask the athletes to <u>limit</u> the time on the infield. We prefer that if athletes are warming up on the infield they are <u>NOT</u> wearing their spikes. Spectators are <u>NOT</u> allowed inside the fenced area.		
Restrooms	Available behind the press box. Middle school and high school bathrooms after 3:45		
Concessions	Will be available behind the bleachers at the bottom of the pressbox. CASH AND CREDIT CARD OPTION FOR PAYMENT		
Locker Rooms	Will be available in the high school for changing purposes only. McFarland High school is not liable for lost or stolen items.		
Bus Parking	See this LINK for parking information. Buses should drop off athletes at Indian Mound Middle School (6330 Exchange Street). After dropping off athletes they should leave the parking lot and return after 4:00 pm to park the bus. If your bus driver is also a track coach, we will be able to accommodate immediate parking.		
Spectator Parking	We ask that spectators come after 3:30 p.m. to park as this allows the parking lots to empty after the high school and middle school dismissal times at 3:35 p.m. and 3:30 p.m See aerial map located below.
