**Awards:** Medals to 1<sup>st</sup> place; ribbons to 2<sup>nd</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup>, place. Team trophies to the 1<sup>st</sup>

place boys' and girls' teams.

**Entries**: 4 athletes per event, except 2 in high jump, 2 teams per

relay, and unlimited in the 100 m. All athletes can score for your team.

Four events per athlete (3/1 or 2/2) Relays count as a running

event. No more than ¼ inch spikes!

**Deadlines**: Entries must be entered online by **Sunday**, **April 27**, **2025**, **by 12:00 p.m**.

**Admissions:** \$3.00 for adults, Students/children are free

**Food:** Concessions will be available.

As you pull into the High School Parking lot, please pull towards the back of the school to drop off the kids. The **coaches meeting/scratches ONLY** will take place between 3:40 and 4:00 in the High School Fieldhouse - Court 1.

In the fieldhouse, you will find your packet with information, records, and a garbage bag to have the kids clean up after the meet. We will also have ham or turkey sub, chips, cookies and water for the coaches. Come in the doors by the greenhouse (Door 21) and head to the Fieldhouse (Court 1) to make your scratches, grab some food and water at the Fieldhouse concession stand, and head out to the track to get things started right away! We will <u>not</u> be officially hosting a meeting unless it is necessary.

Remember to double-check to make sure your 4X100 and 4X100 throwers relays are correct.

NO tape on the track or on the runways for long, triple or high jump. CHALK ONLY! Long and triple jump, <u>may</u> take all 3 jumps in a row. For the shot put and discus, we will be using the "dot" to mark the 3 throws and measure the longest throw. The 100-meter run will have unlimited entries this year.

High Jump (girls/boys) 4:15 3'8" girls start & 4' boys start

Pole Vault (boys & girls combined) 4:15 5' start. – This is a scored event!

Girls/Boys for all running events – these are approximate times. First call will be about 10 minutes before the start, second call 5 minutes, and final call 1 minute before the start. NO Tape. Chalk only!

# WE WILL RUN AHEAD OF SCHEDULE IF POSSIBLE!

**Shot and Disc** – Please warm-up with your **own** shot and disc and we will provide two shots or discus's for the competition. The boys will use an 8.8 lb. HS girls shot (4K) and the girls will use a 6 lb. shot. This is an open pit, 3 throws but to keep the invite moving, have your athletes wait for their running event until the final call and then come right back. This year, we will use the "dot" to mark their throws and measure the longest so they will need to take all 3 throws in a row. Open pit!

**Long Jump** - Athletes <u>may</u> take all 3 jumps in a row. Open pit. **Triple Jump** - Athletes <u>may</u> take all 3 jumps in a row. Open pit!

**High Jump** – Girls will start at 3'8" and the boys will start right after the girls at 4'. You will only have a 10-minute checkout time so have your athletes wait for their running event until the final call and then come right back. If the athlete is not there to jump that height, the bar will be raised and they will have a chance to jump the next height.

REMINDER, NO tape on the track or on the runways for long, triple or high jump or pole vault. CHALK ONLY!

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Sprint Medley (100, 100, 200, 400) – yellow, yellow, blue with cut 4 \times 200 – red, red, yellow 4 \times 100 – yellow, yellow 4 \times 400 – 2^{nd} runner can cut in at the cones at the 100 m
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Exchange Zone Helpers – Highlighted teams, we would greatly appreciate your help at the exchange zones.

2nd exchange – Dodgeville (lanes 1-4) & Fennimore (lanes 5-8)

1st and 3rd exchange – North Crawford (1-4) and Cassville (5-8)

4 X 100 - Regular and Throwers relay - must participate in at least one throwing event.

2nd exchange – MFL Mar Mac (1-4) & Mineral Point (5-8)

3rd exchange – Platteville
