Additional Notes: Athletes are not to loiter in the clubhouse. Portable toilets are available in the lower parking lot. Please encourage your athletes to use these and not the clubhouse facilities. Water will be available in the finish area.

Please remind athletes to be respectful and considerate to all spectators, workers, and golf course properties. **No footballs, Frisbees, etc. on the golf course. No dogs /pets are allowed on golf course properties or at WIAA events.** All team camps are to be to the east of the starting area and south of the parking lot.
