Lowes Creek Country Park	The Husky Cross Country Invite will once again return to Lowe's Creek County Park where we held the race last year!
Directions and Parking	From East I-94: Take exit 68 for WI-93 toward Eleva/Eau Claire. Turn right onto WI-93. Turn right onto Lorch Ave. Turn left onto Fairview Dr. Buses will drop off participants and then we are asking them to park across highway 93 in the Fleet Farm Parking Lot where there will be overflow parking provided. There will be shuttle buses available to bring spectators over to the event. If spectator parking becomes full, we will direct vehicles to park across highway 93 in the Fleet Farm Parking lot. Please use the lot off the south side of Fleet Farm to park. We will have a shuttle bus to bring spectators to/from the event.

Course	Extra copies of the course map will be available on race day. Both boys and girls will be running the same 5K course (see map below).
Entries	Accurate Timing services will be doing the timing and scoring for this meet. You may enter up to 8 runners in the varsity races; JV is unlimited entries. Roster entries are due by noon on Wednesday, August 26th on the MileSplit website (wi.milesplit.com) . There will be race packets and bib numbers to pick up at the finish line when you arrive. They will also have results available after the awards ceremony. Please contact Clark if you have any questions or concerns regarding registration for your team.
Scoring & Awards	Scoring for this meet will be as usual, 1-5 score, 6th runner breaks any tie. For the awards ceremony, because we give out grade level awards , it is critical that you <u>DOUBLE CHECK</u> your rosters and make sure all athletes have their <u>CORRECT GRADE LISTED</u> . We will not be making any corrections to results on race day because of an incorrectly listed grade level. Any and all changes you catch on race day must be made prior to the first race. Thank you!
Awards	Awards will be divided by grade level, no matter which race (V or JV) • Top individual in each grade receives a trophy • 2nd to 10th place individuals in each grade receive a medal • 1st and 2nd place varsity teams receive a plaque.
T-Shirts	Will be available to purchase at the event.
Concessions	A concession stand tent will be stationed near tent city. Food and refreshments will be available.

Water	We will have water jugs and bottled water available for participants, but once we run out, we do not have a way to refill the water at this location. <u>*Due to this we are asking all teams to please make a plan to provide your own water for your athletes and teams. *</u>
Athletic Trainer	An athletic trainer will be on site near the finish line.
