MONDAY, APRIL 15, 2024

This is the 71st annual running of the Prairie Relays. According to the historian for the Wisconsin Track Coaches Association, it is the second oldest continuous outdoor invitational in the state of Wisconsin. The first Prairie Relays was run on April 26, 1954 in a steady downpour on a muddy one-sixth mile track at the City Ball Park, and featured teams from Dodgeville, Prairie du Chien, Boscobel, Lancaster, and Fennimore. Dodgeville won the inaugural meet, topping Prairie du Chien by seven points. Over the years, the meet has grown to as many as fifteen teams, including schools from the La Crosse area and Iowa. In the mid-1980s, the PdC Girls Invitational was dropped and became part of the Prairie Relays.

This year's Prairie Relays features 15 teams. It will be run on Monday, April 15, 2024, beginning at 4:15 **p.m.** at the high school's 8-lane rubberized track facility.

Please be sure that your athletes are using no more than 1/4 inch pyramid spikes.

Scoring will be 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 1 for 6 places.

Awards are medals for the top 3 places in all events and a team plaque for the first place teams.

Each team is allowed 3 athletes per event and one team per relay.

The games committee shall consist of the two WIAA starters, Andy Banasik (PDC) - meet manager, Adrian Ugo (Viroqua) and Kevin Billington (River Valley). This committee will serve as the final board of appeals.

Participating schools will provide a coach to serve as an exchange zone judge in the relays.
