Portable toilets and park bathrooms are available near the start area.

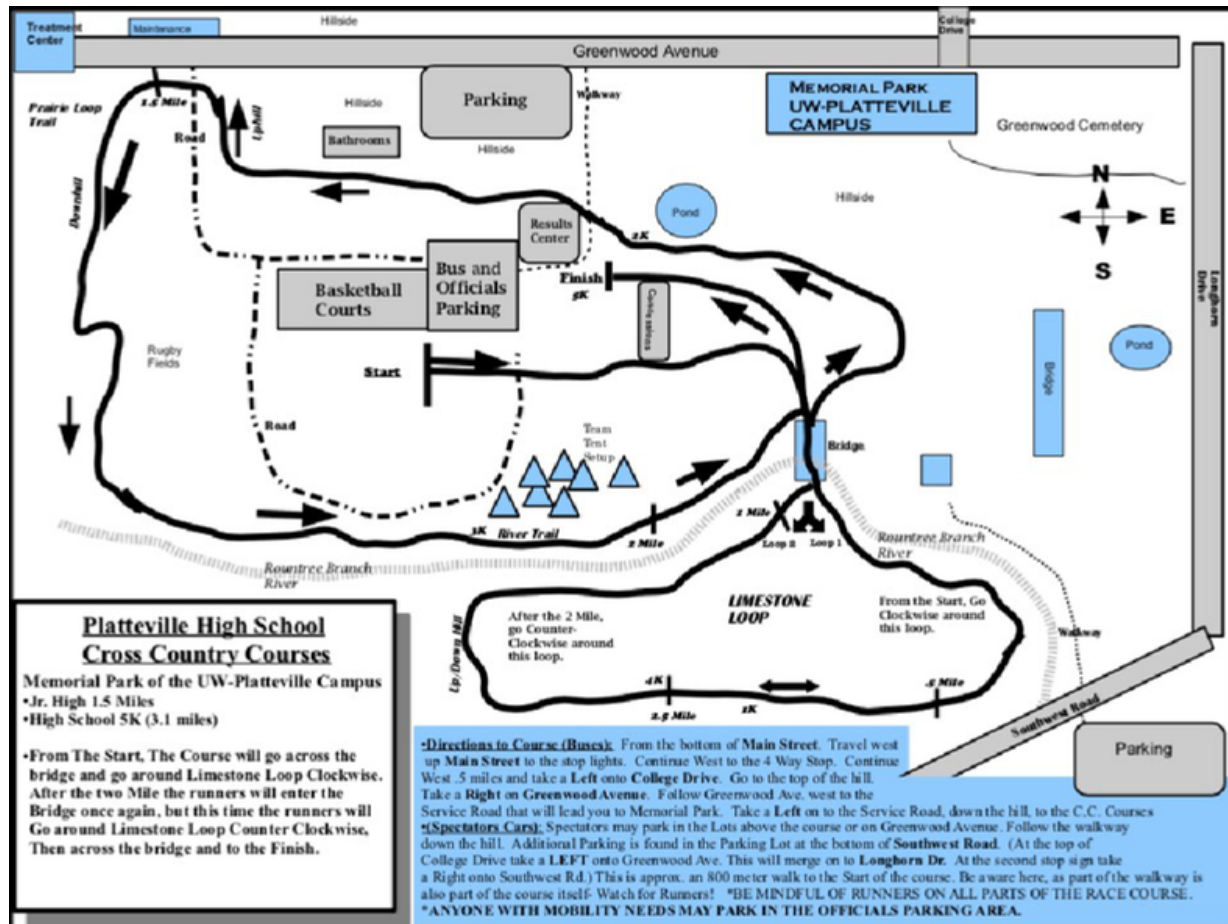
